Opinion

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results ('the Statement') of Elan Imperial Private Limited (formerly known as Ambience Infrastructure Developers Private Limited) ('the Company') for the quarter ended 30 June 2023, attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('Listing Regulations'), including relevant circulars issued by the SEBI from time to time.
- 2. Notes to the financial results:

- These financial results of Elan Imperial Private Limited ('the Company') for the quarter ended 30 June 2023 have been reviewed by statutory auditors of the Company and approved by the Board of Directors ('the Board') at its meeting held on 29th July 2023. These financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles of Indian Accounting Standards as specified in section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013.
- Figures for the quarters ended 31 March 2023 represents the balancing figures between the audited figures for the full financial year and unaudited year to date figure up to third quarter of the financial year.
- In accordance with SEBI circular SEBI/HO/DDHS_Div/P/CIR/2022/0000000103 dated 29 July 2022 and as amended, since the company does not have any corresponding quarterly financial results, and as it was listed in March 2023 the corresponding figures for the preceding three months quarter ended 30th June 2022 and the corresponding figures for the Year To Date for previous year ended 30 June 2022 are not applicable.
- The Company's primary business segment is reflected based on principal business activities carried on by the Company i.e. development of real estate projects and all other related activities, which as per Ind AS 108 on 'Operating Segments' is considered to be the only reportable business segment. The Company is operating in India which is considered as a single geographical segment.
- Code on Social Security, 2020 ('Code') has been notified in the Official Gazette of India on 29 December 2020, which could impact the contributions of the Company towards certain employment benefits. Effective date from which changes are applicable is yet to be notified and the rules are yet to be framed. Impact, if any, of change will be assessed and accounted for in the period of notification of relevant provisions.
- The listed and unlisted non-convertible debentures of the Company aggregating Rs. 200 crores as at 30 June 2023 are secured by way of first mortgage/charge on the Company and asset cover thereof exceeds 100% of the principal amount of the said debentures.
- There is no material deviation in the use of the proceeds of issue of non convertible debentures from the objects stated in the respective offer documents.

- 1. This report is issued in accordance with our master engagement letter.
- 2. We Agarwal Prakash & Co., Chartered Accountants, are the Statutory Auditors of the Company and have been requested by the Company to examine the accompanying Statement showing 'Asset Cover' for the listed non-convertible debt securities as at 30 June 2023 (the "Statement") which has been prepared by the Company from the reviewed financial statements and other relevant records and documents maintained by the Company as at and for the quarter ended 30 June 2023 pursuant to the requirements of the Regulation 56(1)(d) of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, (the "SEBI Regulations"), and has been initiated by us for identification purpose only.

This Report is required by the Company for the purpose of submission with IDBI Trusteeship Services Limited (the "Debenture Trustee") of the Company and to the BSE Limited to ensure compliance with the SEBI Regulations and SEBI Circular SEBI/HO/MIRSD/MIRSO_CRADT/CIR/P/2022/67 dated 19 May 2022 ("the circular") in respect of its listed non-convertible debt securities as at 30 June 2023 ("Debentures"). The Company has entered into agreement(s) with the Debenture Trustee ("Debenture Trust Deed") in respect of such Debentures, as indicated in the Statement.

Management's Responsibility on the Statement

- 3. The preparation of the accompanying Statement including preparation and maintenance of all accounting and other relevant supporting records and documents is solely the responsibility of the management of the Company. This responsibility includes the design, implementation and maintenance of internal controls relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Statement, and applying an appropriate basis of preparation; and making estimates that are reasonable in the circumstances.
- 4. The management is also responsible for ensuring compliance with the relevant requirements of the SEBI Regulations, SEBI Circulars, Companies Act, 2013 and other Applicable Laws and Regulations for the purpose of furnishing the Statement and for providing all other relevant information to the Trustee.



5. The Management is also responsible to ensure that Assets Cover Ratio as on 30 June 2023 is in compliance with SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/MIRSD/MIRSD_CRADT/CIR/P/2022/67 dated 19 May 2022 with the minimum asset cover requirement of hundred percent as per the SEBI Regulations as given in Annexure I attached to this certificate.

Auditor's Responsibility

- 6. Our responsibility, for the purpose of this certificate is to verify the particulars contained in the Statement, on the basis of the audited financial statements and other relevant records and documents maintained by the Company and to certify asset cover ratio is minimum hundred percent as per the minimum requirement stated in SEBI Regulations.
- 7. We have reviewed the Financial Results for the quarter ended 30 June 2023, prepared by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, and issued an unmodified conclusion dated 29 July 2023. Our review of these financial results for the quarter and period ended 30 June 2023 was conducted in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India ("ICAI") respectively.
- 8. We conducted our examination of the Statement in accordance with the Guidance Note on Reports or Certificates for Special Purposes issued by the ICAI. The Guidance Note requires that we comply with the ethical requirements of the Code of Ethics issued by the ICAI.
- 9. We have complied with the relevant applicable requirements of the Standard on Quality Control (SQC) 1, "Quality Control for Firms that Perform Audits and Reviews of Historical Financial Information, and Other Assurance and Related Services Engagements".
- 10. Our scope of work did not involve us performing audit tests for the purposes of expressing an opinion on the fairness or accuracy of any of the financial information or the financial results of the Company taken as a whole. We have not performed an audit, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion on the financial results, specified elements, accounts or items thereof, for the purpose of this report. Accordingly, we do not express such opinion.
- 11. A limited assurance engagement includes performing procedures to obtain sufficient appropriate evidence on the applicable criteria, mentioned in paragraph 6 above. The procedures performed vary in nature and timing from, and are less in extent than for, a reasonable assurance engagement. Consequently, the level of assurance obtained is substantially lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had a reasonable assurance engagement been performed. Accordingly, we have performed the following procedures in relation to the Statement:
 - (a) Obtained and read the Debenture Trust Deed and the Information Memorandum in respect of the secured Debentures and noted the asset cover percentage required to be maintained by the Company in respect of such Debentures, as indicated in Annexure I of the Statement.
 - (b) Traced and agreed the principal amount of the Debentures outstanding as on 30 June 2023 to the reviewed financial statement of the Company and unaudited books of account maintained by the Company as at 30 June 2023;
 - (c) Obtained and read the particulars of asset cover required to be provided in respect of Debentures as indicated in the Debenture Trust Deed and the Information Memorandum.



- (d) Traced the value of assets indicated in Annexure I of the Statement to the reviewed financial statements of the Company and unaudited books of account maintained by the Company as on 30 June 2023.
- (e) Obtained the list of security created in the register of charges maintained by the Company and 'Form No. CHG-9' filed with Ministry of Corporate Affairs. Traced the value of charge created against assets to the asset cover.
- (f) Obtained the list and value of assets placed under lien or encumbrance for the purpose of obtaining any other loan and determined that such assets are not included in the calculation of asset cover in respect of the Debentures.
- (g) Examined and verified the arithmetical accuracy of the computation of asset cover indicated in Annexure I of the Statement.
- 12. We have no responsibility to update this certificate for events and circumstances occurring after the date of this certificate.

Conclusion

13. Based on the procedures performed by us, as referred to in paragraph 11 above and according to the information and explanations received and Management representations obtained, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the Company has not maintained hundred percent asset cover or asset cover as per the terms of the Information Memorandum and Debenture Trust deed.

The Report has been issued at the request of the Company, solely in connection with the purpose mentioned in paragraph 2 above and to be submitted with the accompanying Statement to the BSE Limited and Debenture Trustee and is not to be used or referred to for any other person. Accordingly, we do not accept or assume any liability or any duty of care for any other purpose or to any other person to whom this report is shown or into whose hands it may come.
